8. प्रश्न-पुस्तिका में प्रत्येक प्रश्न के चार वैकल्पिक उत्तर दिये गये हैं। प्रत्येक प्रश्न के इकाईगत उत्तर के लिए आपको OMR उत्तर-पत्र की सम्बन्धित पंक्ति के सामने दिये गये वृत्त की उत्तर-पत्र के प्रथम पृष्ठ पर दिखाने वाले निर्देशों के अनुसार बाल-प्वाइंट पेन से गाढ़ा करना है।
9. प्रत्येक प्रश्न के उत्तर के लिये केवल एक ही वृत्त को गाढ़ा करें। एक से अधिक वृत्त को गाढ़ा करने से उत्तर अवैध है। एक वृत्त को अपूर्ण भरने पर वह उत्तर गलत माना जायेगा।
10. ध्यान दें कि एक बार स्याही द्वारा अंकित उत्तर बदला नहीं जा सकता है। यदि प्रथम दिये गये उत्तर गलत माना जायेगा, तो सम्बन्धित पंक्ति के सामने दिये गये सभी वृत्त को खाली छोड़ दें। अन्यथा प्रश्न गलत उत्तर दिये जायेंगे।
11. रूक-कागज के लिये इस पुस्तिका के मुखपृष्ठ के अंदर वाला पृष्ठ तथा अंतिम वाला पृष्ठ का प्रयोग करें।
12. परीक्षा के उपरान्त अभ्यर्थी ओ०एम०आर० उत्तर-पत्रक परीक्षा कक्ष/भवन में निरीक्षक की अवश्य सौंप दें। जबकि अभ्यर्थियों को प्रश्न-पुस्तिका और ओ०एम०आर० उत्तर-पत्रक की कापी अपने साथ ले जाने की अनुमति है।
13. अभ्यर्थी को परीक्षा समाप्त होने से पहले परीक्षा भवन से बाहर जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी।
14. यदि कोई अभ्यर्थी परीक्षा में अनुचित साधनों का प्रयोग करता है, तो वह विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा नियंत्रित होना का/की भागी होगा/होगी।
