Q1. You recently sent your computer to be repaired at a shop. However, you are not satisfied with the repair. Write a letter to the manager of the shop. In your letter

- describe why your computer needed to be repaired
- explain why you are not happy with the service
- say what you would like the shop manager to do

Q2. You recently went on a sightseeing tour which you did not enjoy. Write a letter to the manager of the tour company. In your letter:

- explain why you chose that particular tour
- explain what you did not like about the tour
- suggest two ways in which the tour could be improved

Q3. You have found out that a building company is planning to build new houses close to your home. Write a letter to the manager of the construction company. In your letter

- say how you found out about their plan
- describe how you feel about the proposed development
- explain what you hope the building company will do

Q4. A TV company is going to make a new program about a place near your home. Write a letter to the head of the production company. In your letter

- explain how you found out about the TV program
- say how you know the place where they plan to film
- suggest some information about the place that could be included in the TV program

Q5. You want to sell some of your furniture. You think a friend of yours might like to buy it from you.

Write a letter to your friend. In your letter

- explain why you are selling
- describe the furniture
- suggest a date when your friend can come and see the furniture

Q6. You made a reservation at a hotel for you and your colleagues to stay during a business trip, but you need to make some changes to your booking. Write a letter to the hotel manager.

In your letter, you should:

- Give details of your booking
- Explain what changes you need to make
- Ask for some special arrangements to be made for your business meetings.
