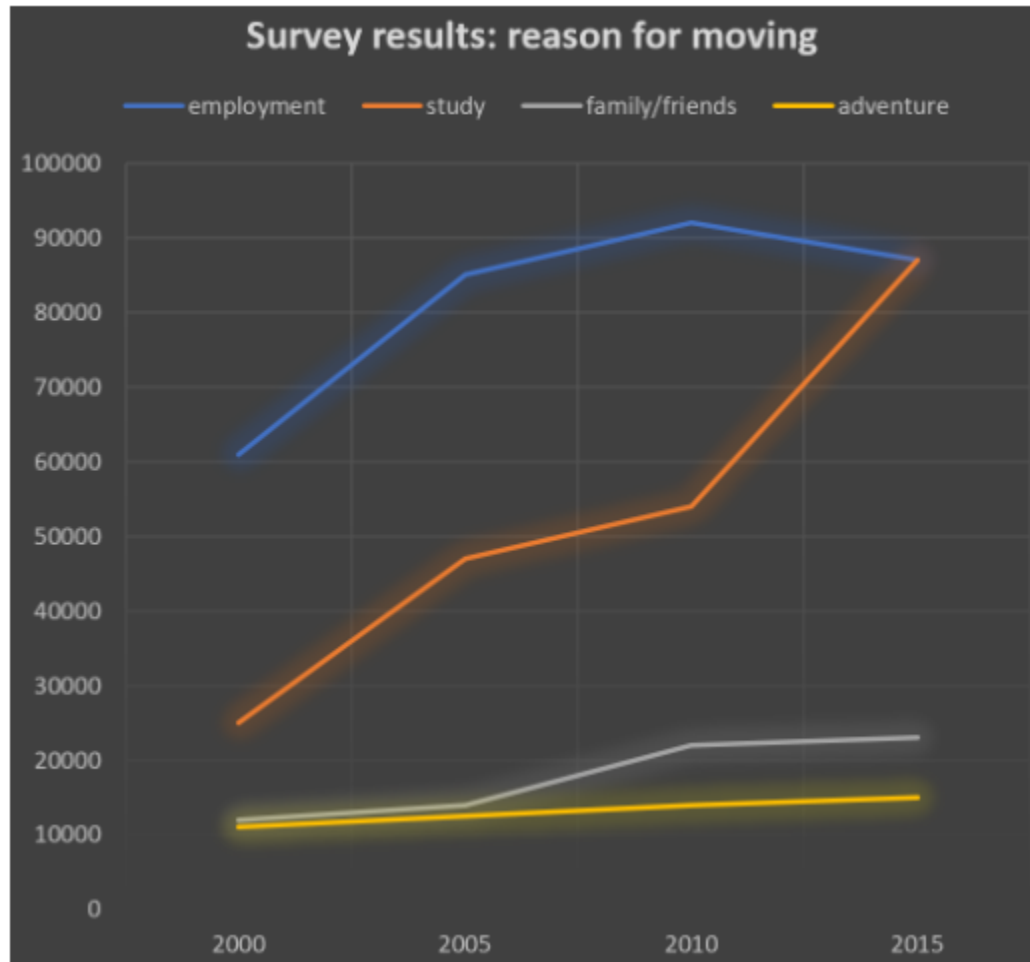

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.



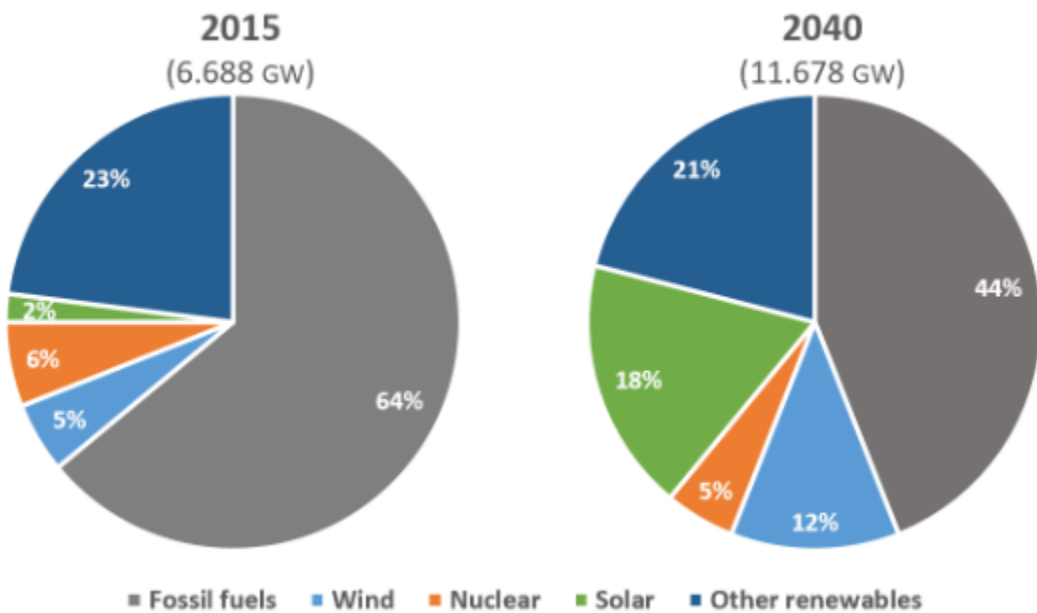

Energy capacity in 2015 and 2040

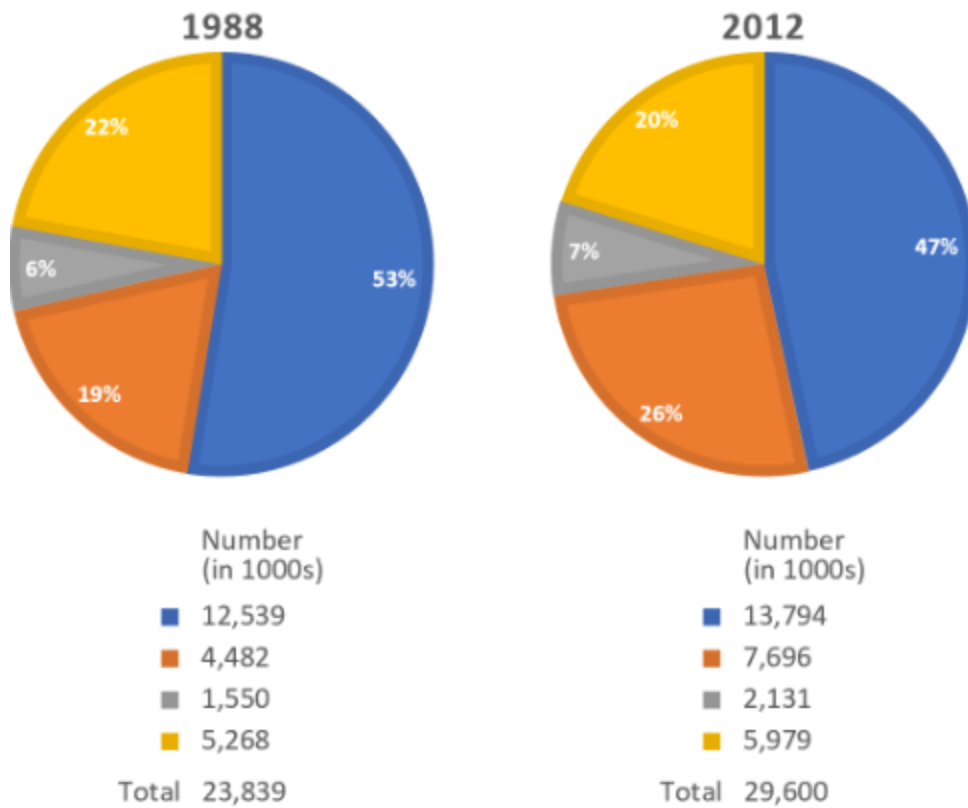


Q4. The charts give information about employment in the UK in 1998 and 2012.

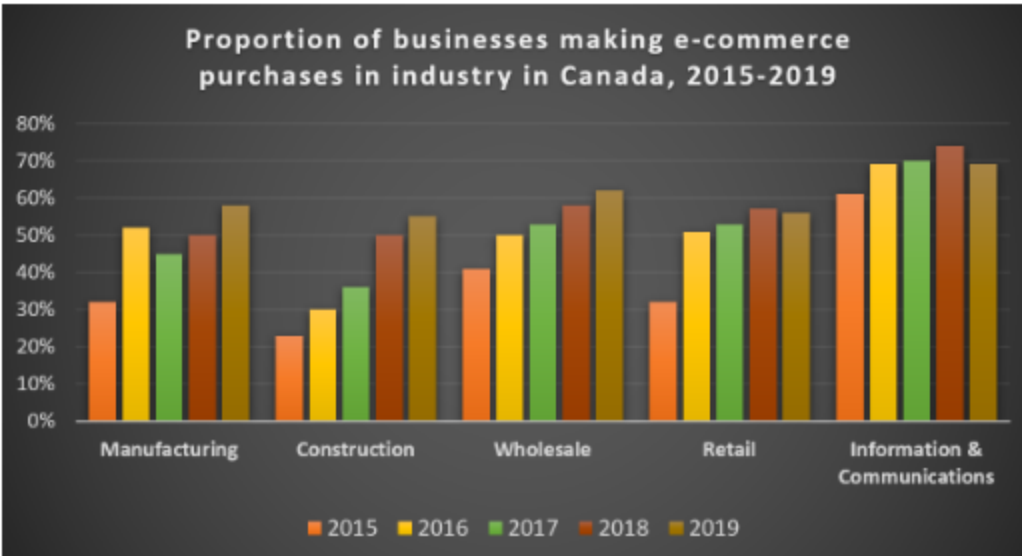
