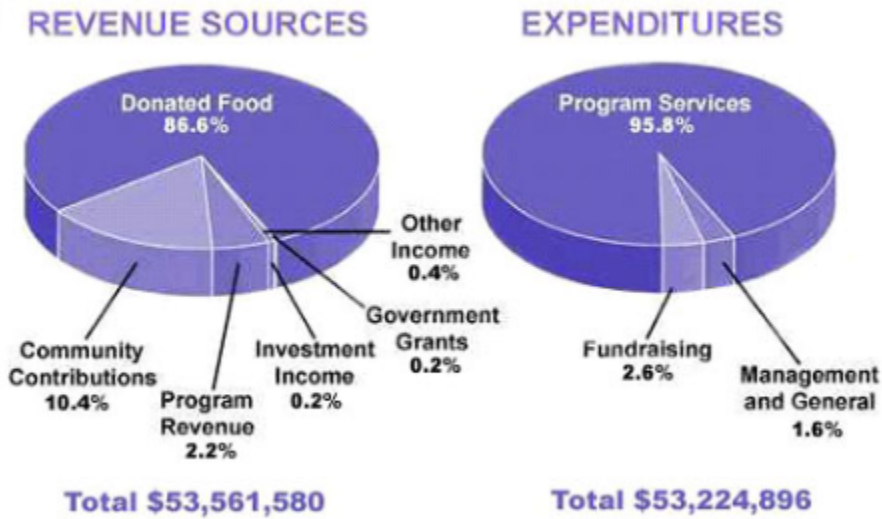

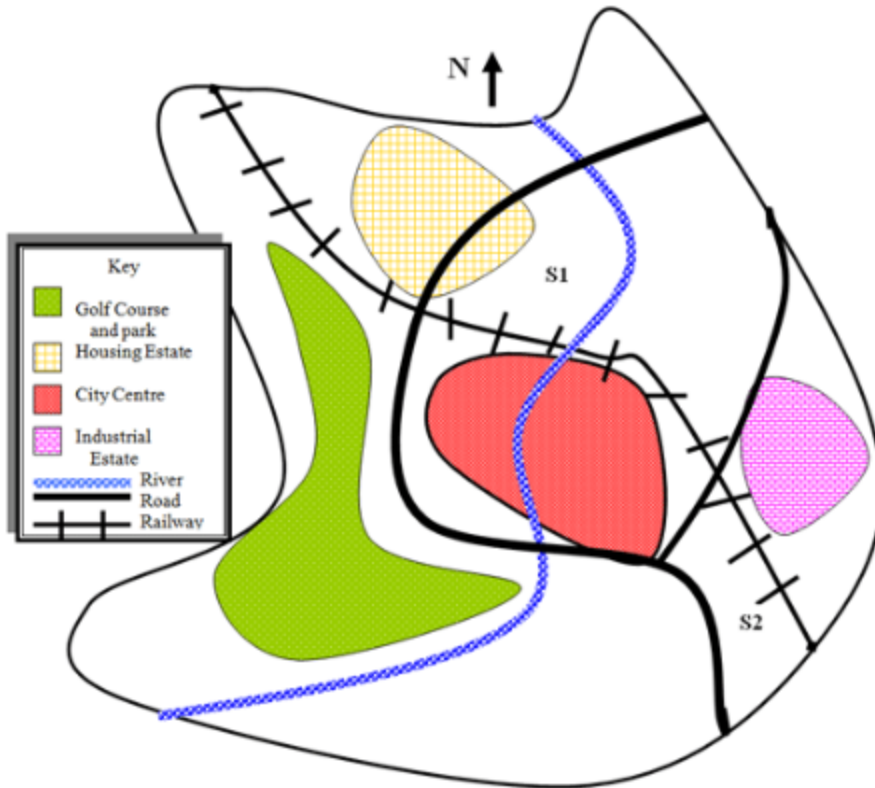
Q1. The amount of money that a children's charity located in the USA spent and received in one year, 2016.



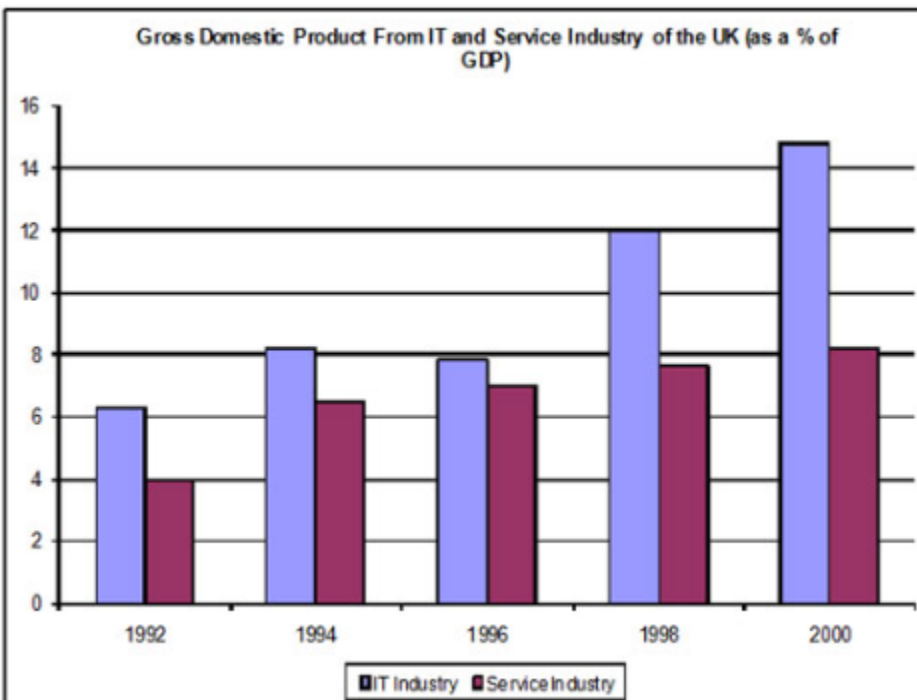
Q2. The Proportions of Pupils Attending Four Secondary School Types Between Between 2000 and 2009.

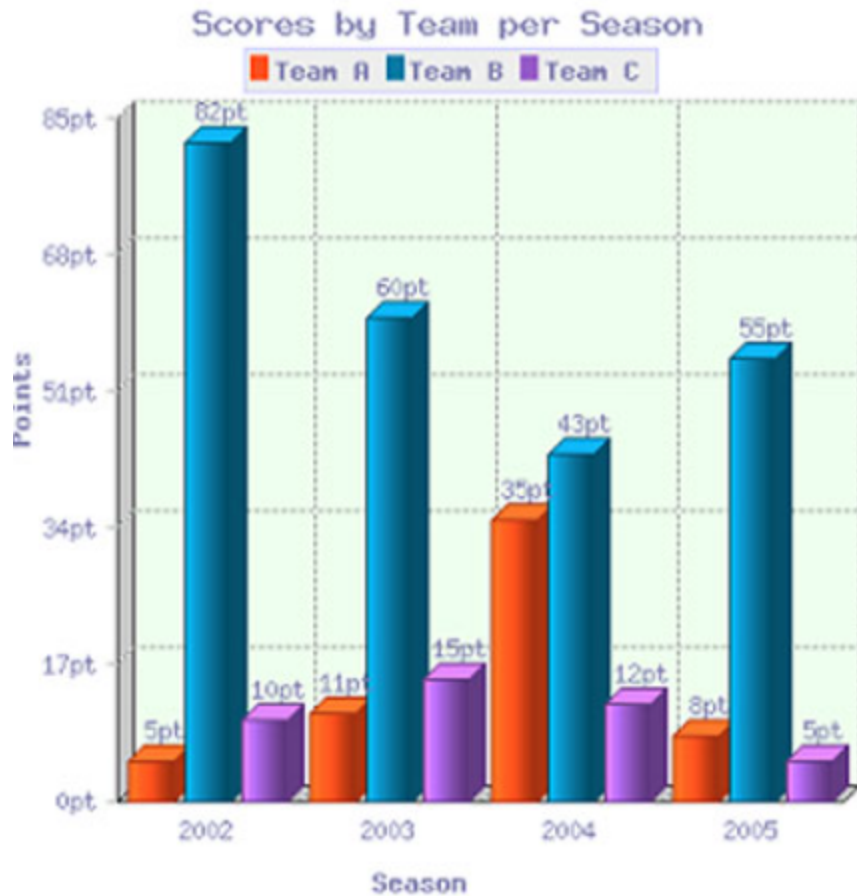
Q3. The city of Brandfield. City planners have decided to build a new shopping mall for the area, and two sites, S1 and S2 have been proposed.
