**NOTE:**

- Hostel fee components (A-1 to a-6) are applicable to the students who are allotted a hostel room. The charges against hostel fee components (A-1 to A-6) will be NIL for those NOT allotted a hostel (such students will not be eligible for any medical benefits normally available to students paying the medical fee). Students may check their hostel room allocation status on semester fee payment link.
- Academic fee payment is mandatory while paying the Hostel fees.
- @Hostel-mess security deposit is a one-time fee during the entire tenure of student stay at hostel. The amount will be refunded while vacating the hostel, provided the concerned student is not charged with any fine for hostel/mess damage.
- Every student staying in hostel has to pay a "per Semester Mess Advance" (SMA) of **Rs. 27,000/-** directly to the hostel allotted.
- Students who are staying in quarters, such as MRSB / Tulsi / QIP, etc. are required to pay License fee, F.R, etc. as applicable to these quarters, as per Estate Office rules. A security deposit as per HCU rules also need to be paid.
- In view of the COVID-19 pandemic, all students, who would be permitted to stay on campus in hostels are required to get the COVID-19 health insurance on their own for a minimum period covering the period of their semesterly stay, before commencement of their stay on campus. The premium paid towards this insurance will be reimbursable up to Rs 500/-, out of the Medical Fee paid, against policy payment invoice/ receipt. Such students need to send an email mentioning their (Name, Roll No. and Hostel No.) with the subject as "[Request for Covid Medical Insurance Premium Reimbursement](#)" along with self-attested photo copy of Health Insurance Policy / Premium Paid Receipt to Dean SA office ([Email: dean.sa.office@iitb.ac.in](mailto:dean.sa.office@iitb.ac.in)) for reimbursement.
- IIT Bombay reserves the rights to revise the hostel fee structure in subsequent semesters.
