# **Letters of Recommendation**

Letters should be on school letterhead stationery.

## **Grade Reports/Transcripts**

You should arrange for Muskingum to receive official or certified copies of your academic records throughout your attendance at secondary school, college, university, and professional institutions of learning. Records should list the individual subjects studied and the grade, mark, or other evidence that each subject was completed to the satisfaction of the authorities in charge. Records should also include certified copies of any diplomas, degrees or other certificates received. All records should be in English. If the language of the records is not English a certified literal translation should be included with the original document. Since certificates and records submitted are not ordinarily returned, you should send certified/official attested copies in addition to originals if the documents in question cannot be easily replaced – the originals will be returned only when accompanied by certified copies. Transcripts/marksheets should be submitted in an envelope sealed and stamped by the issuing institution. Official English translations must also be provided when necessary. **Uncertified photocopies alone are not accepted.** 

## **Test Reports**

Students who are not native speakers of English should submit official results from an accepted test of English proficiency. Contact the Director of International Admission to determine which tests are acceptable. Students from partner institutions abroad must submit a letter from the high school affirming English proficiency at a level appropriate for undergraduate degree study. Applicants not required submitting a TOEFL score must submit SAT or ACT results. All test reports must be sent directly to Muskingum by the testing agency. Muskingum's routing code is 1496 for the SAT and 3300 for the ACT.
