




Eligibility Criteria

- Be a resident citizen of India
- Be currently enrolled in the first year of an eligible undergraduate or postgraduate degree programme in any institution
- Be pursuing an eligible degree programme in Artificial Intelligence, Computer Sciences, Mathematics & Computing, and Electrical and/or Electronics Engineering
- - Fulfil the following academic criteria:
 Undergraduate level: JEE Main (Paper 1) rank <= 35000
 - Postgraduate level: GATE Score >= 550, or a CGPA of 7.5 or above in Undergraduate (or % normalized to CGPA)
