# SCHOLARSHIP POLICY 2022-23 DR VISHWANATH KARAD MIT-WORLD PEACE UNIVERSITY [MIT-WPU], PUNE

#### Introduction

Merit scholarships are proposed to reward and motivate the meritorious students with financial assistance based on their academic performance, the performance in proposed National level/State Level entrance including MIT - WPU internal tests (UGPET & PGPET) for the A.Y.2022-23.

The categories of Merit Scholarships are detailed below.

- <u>Dr. Vishwanath Karad Merit Scholarship AY 2022-23:</u> This scholarship provides 100% fee waiver for the entire duration of the program to the *top 5% meritorious* students, based on the approved intake of each program subject to the fulfilment of conditions mentioned under respective policy.
- 2. <u>MIT-WPU Merit Scholarship AY 2022-23:</u> This scholarship is based on the merit of the students and applicable to the first year of the program[s] and valid for the academic year where it is announced. In this Merit Scholarship, there are 5 categories of Scholarships namely 1) 100% fee waiver 2) 75% fee waiver 3) 50% fee waiver 4) 25% fee waiver 5) 10% fee waiver.
- 3. <u>Scholarship to Rank Holders AY 2022-23</u>: This scholarship is awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> rank holders of the select programs every year based on their performance in MITWPU annual examinations as mentioned in Point No.4. This scholarship is applicable to the eligible students' form Second year onwards for any given program.
- 4. <u>Scholarships to Elite Sportsperson AY 2022-23:</u> This scholarship is awarded to deserving sports persons based on their participation/winning the prizes at National/International recognized sports competitions/events.
- 5. Scholarship Awarded to Wards of MIT-WPU/ MAEER's Staff Members: -
- 6. <u>Other Scholarships</u>:- Please refer the scholarship policy page No.28 for other scholarships awarded by the MIT-WPU.
- 7. <u>Special Scholarships</u>: This scholarship will be awarded to the students having high potential in the fields such as entrepreneurship & Innovation, Sports, Arts, Cultural, Design, Media, Social Activities.

The criteria for awarding the scholarships for various programs and categories are given in the subsequent paragraphs.

#### 1. Dr. Vishwanath Karad Merit Scholarship 2022-23.

	This scholarship provides 100% fee waiver for the entire duration of the program subjected to the fulfilment of the below-mentioned conditions by the student and the conditions amended from time to time by the University.
	Number of scholarships to be awarded is 5% of the approved intake for the respective program.
	The Scholarship shall be awarded to eligible students on First Come-First Served basis.
	The eligible student for 100% fee waiver scholarship, needs to pay the provisional admission fee / first instalment of fee on or before the last date of admission notification.
	The Provisional Admission Fee / First instalment of fee paid by the student who has been awarded Dr. VDK 100% fee waiver scholarship which is for entire duration of program will be refunded after the final announcement of awarding the scholarships.
	Scholarship percentage is given on Total Fees.

#### The Terms and Conditions to award "Dr Vishwanath Karad Merit Scholarship": -

i. The continuation of 100% Scholarship for SY/TY & Final Year would subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

#### Academic Performance: -

To continue this Scholarship for the total duration of the program, the student should maintain a minimum **CGPA** of 8 and above throughout all trimesters/semesters of every year with no backlog in any subject/ Program and no trimester/semesters break.

#### > Attendance: -

The student must maintain a minimum attendance of **80**% per trimester/semesters after catering for all exigencies including illness, sports and any other requirement.

#### > Discipline: -

The student must maintain good conduct, behavior, and discipline as per the disciplinary norms of the University. Any violations of University disciplinary norms and the student is issued a written warning/memo will lead to forfeit of scholarship immediately for ongoing as well as subsequent years.

ii. In case of cancellation of admission, the scholarship would stand 'null & void' and the student must pay back the total fee waiver given to him/her by the University till the time of Cancellation of Admission.

## 3. Scholarship to Rank Holders: -

This scholarship is awarded to the rank holders of UG, PG & Integrated Diploma [6Yrs.] programs (expect M. Tech & M. Pharm where stipend is applicable) every year who secure 1st & 2nd ranks in respective MIT-WPU annual examinations. This Scholarship will be awarded to eligible students from second year onwards & not applicable to the students who are already availing Dr. Vishwanath Karad 100% Merit Scholarship & to those who are availing any type of stipend. The first topper is eligible for 50% & the second topper is eligible for 25% scholarship.

#### > These rankers from each program would be selected as follows,

- For each given program, while going into second year or every subsequent year; a
   comprehensive merit list would be drawn considering the entire strength of
   progressing students under that program.
- Number of eligible students for this category are selected for given program by multiplying the number of divisions by 2 when placed in descending order of their merit in CGPA.
- Out of the above number, the first half number of students would be awarded 50% & second half number of students would be awarded 25% scholarship.

#### > Explanation:

- B Tech Computer Science & Engineering has 420 students i.e. equal to 420/60=7 divisions. Therefore, assuming all the students move ahead, out of the comprehensive merit list of 420 students, 7\*2=14 top students would be selected for this scholarship.
- Out of these 14 students, first 07 would be eligible for 50% scholarship & next 07 would be eligible for 25% scholarship. ## 6. Other Scholarships: -

- a) <u>Alumni Scholarship</u>: Any student from any School/ College/ University of MAEER Group who completes Class 10/Class12/Graduation & takes admission in MIT-WPU without any break of Academic Year would be eligible for scholarship of 10% of fees for the first year of the Program provided he/ she scores minimum of 60% marks/Grade in the qualifying examination.
- b) <u>PMSS Scholarship</u>: The candidate admitted directly through AICTE under PMSSS, will have to pay international study tour cost component, either at the time of admission or before the tour, if he/ she wishes to go for international study tour. This international study tour shall be completely optional for students admitted under the PMSSS quota.
  - Also, the candidate shall apply for online scholarship under the said scheme & shall be granted the scholarship/ fee concession only for the amount that is equal to the difference between total fee & the amount reimbursed from AICTE which shall be applicable for the entire duration of the program.
- c) <u>Defense Scholarship</u>: Wards of personnel working in or retired from Defense Services/ Para-military services would be given 25% Scholarship for Non-Commissioned Officers (NCO's), 15% for Junior Commissioned Officers (JCO's) & 10% for Senior Commissioned Officers. Applicable for first year only.
- d) <u>Hon'ble Sri. T N Seshan Scholarship</u>: For School of Public Policy, we offer "Hon'ble Sri. T N Seshan Scholarship". The wards of In-Service Public Servants with a minimum of 5 years of experience in Government Service would be given a scholarship of 15% in the Program Fee.

- d) University shall have the right to utilize the scholarship awardee for promotional activities.
