Rules and Regulations

1. Registration

- 1.1 The registration fee is ₹209 per student, but as part of an early bird offer, students may register for ₹189 for a limited period of time.
- 1.2 Deadline for registration and payment is 30th October, 2020.
- 1.3 Procedure for individual registration:
- Visit https://www.ecosocsrcc.com/NEO.
- Click on 'Register '.
- Login to D2C (Dare2Compete) using your Facebook/Google/LinkedIn account. You may also create a new account.
- Enter your personal credentials. Please enter your school name in the organization field.
- · Click on 'Submit'.
- Click on 'Proceed to Payment' and make the payment of the registration fees.
- Submit the additional details like City, State, Country and Referral Code (if any) after the payment. The form asking for these details might take a few seconds to load up after the payment is complete. Do **NOT** miss this step after the payment.
- On making the payment, you will get a payment confirmation e-mail. After making the payment, you can access the Sample Question Booklet on your Dare2Compete dashboard on the NEO page, shown as the first round.
- Further instructions regarding the Olympiad will be conveyed to you a few days before the Olympiad over e-mail, so we request you to check your e-mail on a regular basis to receive the updates.
- 1.4 The Olympiad shall be conducted over **SpeedExam.net** and the login credentials shall be shared over e-mail to the candidates a few days before the examination.

2. Structure of NEO

- 2.1 The examination consists of two rounds:
 - Preliminary Round (Classes XI and XII: 1st November, 2020)
 - Final Round (8th November, 2020)

Timings of Preliminary Round: Class XI: 3-4 PM and Class XII: 5-6 PM

- 2.2 Both the rounds will be conducted **online**. All candidates are requested to make timely arrangements for a laptop/desktop suitable for answering the examination. We strongly discourage the use of a smartphone to take the examination.
- 2.3 Participants are expected to have an adequately strong internet connection. The organisation will not be responsible for any connectivity issues faced by the student during the examination.
- 2.4 The examination is an assessment of students' analytical and problem-solving skills. The question set will include case studies based on contemporary issues, multiple choice questions, among others. There is no fixed syllabus for the examination. The preliminary round will be divided into 4 sections covering logical reasoning, economic concepts, data interpretation and case studies.
- 2.5 No prior preparation is required for the Olympiad. However, a **Sample Question Booklet** will be shared after the student completes the registration procedure for him to get a brief idea of what the Olympiad entails of.
- 2.6 Once the examination starts, the candidate can only leave the page at the termination of the stipulated time. Any attempts to open a different window/tab will lead to the **cancellation** of the respective candidate's responses.
