

## Plaksha University Undergraduate Admissions Policies

## **Eligibility:**

- Applicants should be currently enrolled in grade 12 or equivalent or should have completed grade 12 or equivalent.
- Plaksha accepts students from all recognised national and international boards.
- All students should have studied Mathematics till grade 12.
- Students wishing to opt for majors in Computer Science & Artificial Intelligence, Robotics & Cyber-Physical Systems and Biological Systems Engineering should also have studied Physics till grade 12.
- Students wishing to opt for a major in Data Science, Economics and Business should have studied Math till grade 12 and can be from a non-science background.
- Required Scores
  - To receive a confirmed offer of admission, applicants are required to submit <u>at least</u>
     one of the following scores:
    - Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)
    - American College Testing (ACT)
    - Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Main
    - Grade 12th (or equivalent) Board Results
- **Grade X** -Best of 5 scores considered, including Math and Science.
- **Grade XII** Best of 4 scores considered, including Math and Physics for National and State Boards. Minimum 3 A Level for IGCSE Boards. Best of 6 scores, including Math and Physics for IB Boards. Only Math if the student is from a non-science background.
- Students who apply using only predicted scores may go through an extra stage of evaluation.
  - The College Board Designated Institution (DI) code for Plaksha is 7837. Indian students can send their scores free to Plaksha through their official College Board account.
  - The offer of admission will be revoked in any case where the applicant does not clear grade 12 satisfactorily.
- A minimum of three subjects are required to apply, for students with Cambridge International A levels.
- International Baccalaureate (IB) specific policies
  - We accept students from both IB Diploma Programme and IB Certificate

    Course, as long as applicants have the subject prerequisites. Students in IB

    Certificate Course, should have taken a minimum of 6 subjects (3 Standard Level and 3 Higher Level).
  - We also accept students from "The International Baccalaureate (IB) Career-related Programme (CP)". It will still be mandatory for the students to have Math and Physics as their DP courses to qualify for Plaksha.
  - We accept the following variants of Mathematics –



- Analysis and Approaches: Higher Level and Standard Level
- Applications and Interpretations: Higher Level

## **Admissions Process:**

- An applicant can apply only once in any of the four rounds of the Admissions cycle 2021-22.
   There is no difference in applying in either of the four rounds. We encourage applicants to apply early, so that they receive their decision earlier.
- The Financial Aid form will be open to candidates only after they have been shortlisted for the interview round.
- The choice of preferred Major specified in the application form is only indicative in nature. You are free to change it during the program when you declare your major.
- We will not consider requests for re-evaluation. The decisions taken by the Admissions Committee are final.
- All applicants are required to upload copies of their official transcripts for the standardized tests.

## **Types of Decisions:**

- Firm Offer: A candidate is eligible to receive a firm offer of admission from Plaksha based on the information submitted in the application as well as their performance in the Innovation Challenge and personal conversation rounds. Scores from classes 9 to 12 will be required at the application stage. Candidates can also submit any of the following tests: SAT, ACT, JEE Main. In the absence of Grade 12 or equivalent examination final scores, a candidate is required to submit predicted scores, which are indicative of their performance in their final Grade 12 or equivalent examination results. In exceptional cases, firm offers can be made on the basis of the student's predicted scores.
- **Conditional Offer**: The candidate is required to meet the condition which is mentioned in the decision letter received from the Office of Admissions.
- **Deferral of Decision**: The candidate's application will be re-evaluated no later than August 1, 2022\* (subject to final Grade 12 or equivalent examination results)
- Denial of Admission: The admissions committee is unable to admit the student after carefully evaluating all the information provided by them.
