#### INTRODUCTION

The Kerala Agricultural University is an institution which came into existence on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1971 by the Act passed by the Government of Kerala. The University is the principal instrument of Kerala state in providing human resources, skills and technology required for the sustainable development of its agriculture, agricultural engineering, horticulture and forestry by integrating education, research and extension.

The University fulfills its mission through a network of institutions spread throughout the State consisting of three faculties under which are 8 constituent Colleges, 6 Regional Agricultural Research Stations, 16 Research Stations, one Central Training Institute, one Communication Centre and seven Krishi Vigyan Kendras. There is a network of libraries, including a Central Library in the main campus, constituent Colleges, RARS, Research Stations and KVKs.

Post-graduate programmes are offered in almost all the disciplines with specializations related to agriculture, agricultural engineering and forestry. The university offers post-graduate programmes leading to Master's degree in 32 disciplines and Doctoral programmes in 25 disciplines.

Only Indian nationals are eligible to apply. Candidates should have obtained degrees from a University/Institution accredited by ICAR and recognised by KAU.

Eligibility Criteria for the admission of ICAR students will be as per ICAR norms.

## a) Ph.D in Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Forestry/ Agricultural Engineering

Master's Degree in the respective discipline /related discipline from the faculty concerned. A basic degree in Agri./ Hort./ Forestry/ Ag. Engg. is essential. Basic Degree UG 4 years + PG 2 years from a University / Institution accredited by ICAR will be strictly followed

#### b) Ph.D in Community Science

M Sc. in Community Science or equivalent recognized by KAU.

#### 3. System of Teaching and Evaluation

Semester system of instruction and internal/external evaluation will be followed.

#### 4. Reservation of seats and admission for sponsored candidates

30% of the seats shall be reserved for the eligible ICAR candidates on the basis of All India Entrance Examination conducted by ICAR. At the time of admission, ICAR candidates have to fill the Bio data and remit the fees as prescribed by KAU.

Number of students from outside Kerala is restricted to 10% of the total PG/Ph D seats of KAU, in addition to ICAR allotment. If sufficient students are not available from Kerala, students from outside Kerala will be admitted over and above 10%.

#### In service candidates

Candidates sponsored by the Govt. of Kerala are admitted over and above the intake capacity subject to availability of faculty and facilities. Intending candidates will have to submit their application through their employers concerned within the stipulated time and should attach a certificate of sponsorship and experience from the concerned employer. They should also satisfy the required qualification for admission. They are exempted from writing entrance examination. Sponsored candidate is a candidate deputed by the respective development department, research institutions of national importance, Commodity Boards and other Government and Quasi Government development institutions. The expenditure

towards the Post Graduate programme of such students will be met by the sponsoring agency or the student. One seat each for <u>M Sc. (Ag.) Plant Physiology and M Sc. (Ag.) Agricultural Entomology</u> will be reserved for the candidates from the Union Territory of Lakshadweep provided that the entire expenditure on account of the programme is met by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. At the time of admission, candidates have to fill the Bio data and remit the fees as prescribed by KAU.

## KAU sponsored candidates:-

KAU sponsored candidates have to apply via the admission portal for admission to PhD programmes. Candidates must attach a No Objection Certificate issued by the Registrar along with the hard copy of application and submit the same through the Head of Institution. Advance copy will not be considered. Their admissions will be considered based on granting of study leave by KAU, subject to fulfilling of other requirements for admission.

#### 5. How to Apply

Application forms and prospectus for admission are available in the KAU website <a href="www.admissions.kau.in">www.admissions.kau.in</a>. Candidate should submit the application online after registering in the website. Applications submitted late or found defective or incomplete in any manner or which do not contain any of the enclosures specified are liable to be summarily rejected. The candidates are advised to read the instructions given in the website carefully before filling up the application. Hard copy of application of employed candidates should be routed through their Heads of Institutions.

#### **Payment of Application Fee**

Application fee can be paid online by using the internet facility "SB COLLECT" of State Bank of India for which a link is provided in the application portal and after payment of application fee, candidate should take a print out of online payment receipt from website. Candidates can also remit the application fee directly at any of the branches of State Bank of India by showing the chalan generated through "SB COLLECT" and the bank will issue an Online Receipt on payment of the same. Any other mode of payment will not be accepted. The Application fee /additional fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

**NB:** The candidates are required to enter details of the fee paid in the online application form. Application forms without receipt of online payment attached will be summarily rejected. Candidates must ensure the payment before attaching the online receipt of payment.

#### 6. Application Enclosures

Each application should contain the following documents as enclosures:

- a. Online payment receipt of the application fee.
- b. Scanned copies of certificates in proof of mark list of qualifying examination/ provisional degree certificate/degree certificate with OGPA.
- c. Valid ICAR Score Card (2022-2023), Valid GATE Score Card in case of M.Tech Programmes
- d. PWD/Community/NCLC/ EWS Certificate in case of reservation Candidates.
- e. Certificates in proof of experience, sports, arts, publication.
- f. The details of published papers should be furnished as follows:
  - Original research paper
  - Text books (authored or edited)
  - Chapter in Text Book
  - Review articles in research journals Research note
  - Popular science articles
- g. A 'no objection certificate' and experience certificate obtained from the controlling officer concerned in the case of in-service candidates. Registrar will be the controlling officer for KAU employees.

# 7. Penalty for false information

Any candidate who is found to have willfully or otherwise furnished any particulars which are false or has suppressed material facts or does not satisfy the requisite qualification for admission shall be disqualified. They shall not be allowed to continue on the rolls of the University, if it is detected at any stage of his/her studentship in the University. In case the candidate has already graduated from the University, then the degree awarded by the University will be withdrawn.

#### 8. SELECTION

#### a. Masters

Selection of candidates for the master's degree programmes will be based on ICAR entrance (AIEE-PG) examinations conducted for the academic session 2022-23 for M.Sc. (Ag), M.Sc. (Hort), M.Sc. (Forestry) and M.Tech (Ag. Engg.).

KAU will conduct separate entrance exam for Community Science and Co-operation & Banking courses.

Candidates with valid **GATE score** also will be considered for admission to **M.Tech. Programme** in Agricultural Engineering. GATE score in Agricultural Engineering will be considered for admission to all M.Tech. disciplines of Agricultural Engineering. GATE score in Food Technology will be considered for admission to M.Tech. (Processing & Food Engineering).

Selection of candidates will be based on the ICAR Entrance examination (AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D) conducted for the academic session 2022-23. KAU will conduct separate entrance exam for Community Science.

Reservation rules of Government of Kerala will be applicable for admission to all PG/PhD programmes. PG/PhD disciplines of the concerned faculty will be considered as a separate groups for allotment of reservation on rotation basis. A detailed list of seats reserved to various communities for this year admission is appended as Annexure - I & II.

#### 9. Rejection of application and disqualification of candidates

- 1. Applications defective or incomplete in any manner or which do not contain any of the enclosures specified above are liable to be summarily rejected.
- 2. Applicants who attempt to canvas or influence directly or otherwise will be disqualified.

#### **10.** Test

Candidates will be required to attend test for M.Sc. (C&B), M.Sc. (Community Science) and Ph.D Community Science at the place and time to be notified at their own expense. Late coming candidates will not be permitted to write the examination. Similarly, candidates will be allowed to leave the examination hall only 30 minutes after the commencement of the examination.

#### 11. Announcement of results

The list of candidates provisionally selected for admission and the dates on which they have to remit the fees and physically join the course will be published through KAU Website www.admissions.kau.in

#### 12. Admission

Originals of all certificates and documents should be produced at the time of admission. Those who do not produce the original documents at the time of admission shall forfeit their seat and the seats will be allotted to the next eligible candidate from the rank list/waiting list or in any other manner deemed fit by the University.

Candidates selected will be admitted to the course, provided they pay the prescribed fees in full on the due date fixed.

In the case of those candidates provisionally selected for admission who have not paid the fees on time and not joined the course on the date fixed, their claims for admission will be cancelled without notice and the seat thus becoming vacant will be filled up with eligible candidates, if any, from the rank/ wait list.

Candidates in Government service/University service should make their own arrangements to get relieved from their posts in time.

#### ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

- a) Certificates in proof of qualifications
- b) Certificate in proof of Date of Birth
- c) Nativity Certificate
- d) Non Creamy Layer Certificate (NCLC) / EWS Certificate in case of reservation candidates other than SC/ST
- e) Community Certificate (for SC/ST candidates of Kerala Native only)
- f) Medical Certificate issued by the competent authority in the case of Physically Challenged candidates
- g) Aadhar Card
- h) Certificate from the head of institution to the effect that the institution is under the University which is accredited by the ICAR / will come under the umbrella of the NARS of ICAR in the case of candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from outside Kerala.
- i) Transfer Certificate
- j) Conduct certificate
- k) Medical fitness certificate obtained from a Govt. Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon.
- 1) Score card of ICAR JRF/SRF or GATE Score Card (as applicable)

Candidates who secured their degrees from Universities outside the Kerala State should produce Migration Certificate within one month of provisional admission.

- Note: 1. Candidates whose original certificates are in any language other than English should produce translate certificate from competent authority.
  - 2. Kindly visit the University website (www.kau.in) for updates at frequent intervals.

# All those who take admission and discontinue the course shall be liable to pay liquidated damages to the University as decided by the authorities.

The Registrar, Kerala Agricultural University is authorized to close the admission at any date after the commencement of first semester of course.

A student provisionally admitted to the programmes should physically report to the Dean of Faculty/ Dean concerned on the date of registration with the Bio-data cum Admit Card and all certificate in physical. Failure to report at the college/ institution without prior permission will lose their admission without further notice.

ICAR candidates should report for admission at KAU Head Quarters on the date and time announced by KAU with the documents prescribed by ICAR. Colleges will be allotted to the candidates considering their option and the availability of faculty for research guidance at college.

#### 13. Residential Facilities

Hostel facilities will be provided depending on availability.

#### 14. Fees

The fees for Post-graduate courses are as indicated in Annexure-III, but are liable to be revised by the University and admitted students shall follow it. A special caution deposit of Rs.3000/- is to be paid at the time of admission in the case of candidates from outside the State of Kerala. This will be refunded when he/she leaves the University after completion of the course.

*Note:* Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

#### 15 Exemption from payment of fees

Fee exemptions to the SC/ST students are applicable to only those who belong to the state of Kerala. SC/ST candidates with nativity other than Kerala will be treated as General Candidates Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates may be given exemption from payment of fees subject to the grant of concession by the Scheduled Caste Development Department, Govt. of Kerala. However, they will have to pay various caution deposits and admission fees. They should also submit applications for concession in the prescribed form to the college concerned.

No exemption from payment of fees will be granted to candidates who are likely to be eligible for any other type of fee concession. But the fees paid by them will be reimbursed as and when the concessions are sanctioned.

No relaxation with regard to payment of fees will be allowed in the case of employees on deputation/study leave or those who are holders of ICAR Fellowships. They shall have to remit fees on the due dates prescribed and make their own arrangements to get the same reimbursed from the respective authorities.

The High Court of Kerala will be the only judicial body to decide on the disputes arising if any, in the matter of admission.

The prospectus is subject to further modification/ addition as may be considered necessary by the University and will be issued as executive orders/ notifications and the students are liable to obey the rules and regulations so amended or modified.

#### 16 WARNING

Ragging is a criminal offence as per the 'Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997 of Kerala'. Students indulging in such activities will be punished as per law.
