

CBSE Class 12 Result 2024

CBSE class 12 result has been released on May 13, 2024. You can check your result on any of the three CBSE official websites- cbseresults.nic.in, results.cbse.nic.in and cbse.gov.in.

- CBSE Class 12th results have been declared for over 39 Lakh Students from 26 different countries.
- You need to score a minimum of 33% to pass your Board Exams. In 2023, the pass percentage for CBSE Class 12 Results was 87.33% which was lower than 92.71% in 2022.
- CBSE has released a proposed schedule for reverification and revaluation of answer sheets on its official website cbse.gov.in.

You can check your CBSE Class 12 Results using your admit card ID, roll number, and school number. Your CBSE Class 12 Result 2024 will also be available on the DigiLocker and UMANG App.

Last year, CBSE shared the six-digit security PIN with the affiliated schools for the DigiLocker account activation process. This year too, the board has shared six-digit security code with its affiliated schools. You can get your security PIN from your respective schools only. Once you receive the security PIN, you need to activate your account on DigiLocker to get the CBSE class 12 results.

Some days earlier, DigiLocker also asked students to activate their accounts as “CBSE Results are Coming Soon!” reads DigiLocker official website.

The online CBSE class 12 marksheet contains the total marks of students in each subject. The theory and practical marks are also mentioned separately in the scorecard. Students can calculate their overall percentage by dividing the sum of marks scored in the main 5 subjects by the total marks. [Details to Check on CBSE Class 12 Result 2024](#)

The maximum marks for a subject in CBSE Board are 100 making a total of 500 marks for the main 5 subjects. You are required to score at least 33% marks in each subject to pass in CBSE class 12th result 2024. In case, you are not satisfied with your marks, you can apply for revaluation of answer sheets.

CBSE Results 2024 Class 12 Date and Time

CBSE has not yet confirmed CBSE results 2024 class 12 date and time yet, however, it has confirmed that results are likely after May 20, 2024. As per the recent reports, the evaluation of answer sheets have been completed and the results are in the final phase of compilation.

How to Check CBSE Class 12 Result 2024?

The Central Board of Secondary Education released CBSE class 12 result on its official website cbseresults.nic.in. However, students can access their class 12 results through various other methods including:

- SMS Mode
- IVRS
- DigiLocker or UMANG Application
- SMS Organizer App

The detailed procedure for checking CBSE class 12 result 2024 through each mode is provided below.

Steps to Check CBSE 12 Result through Official Website

This is the most common and preferred method to check CBSE class 12 result. In order to check the results, you are required to visit the official website and enter their login credentials. Given below are the steps to check the result.

Step 1: Go to the official website - cbseresults.nic.in.

Step 2: On the homepage, click on the 'Senior School Certificate Examination Class XII Results 2024' link.

Step 3: The result login window will open up on the screen.

Step 4: Enter your roll number, school number, and [CBSE 12 admit card](#) ID in the appropriate fields.

Step 6: It is recommended to take a printout or screenshot of the CBSE class 12 result for future reference.

Steps to Check CBSE Class 12 Result via SMS

In case of any network issues, you can use the SMS facility to access their results. The steps to check CBSE class 12th result 2024 through SMS are as follows:

Step 1: Type an SMS in the format: cbse12_Roll No._School No._Center No.

Step 2: Now send this message to 7738299899.

Step 3: CBSE 12 result 2024 will be received on the same phone number through SMS.

How to Check CBSE Class 12 Result 2024 on UMANG App?

CBSE class 12th results are available on the UMANG app also. The Unified Mobile Application for New-Age Governance (commonly called UMANG app), is a unified platform to access the major State and Central Government services. The app is a digital platform to store and access all the main documents. Students can access their mark sheets and other academic certificates from the UMANG app.

UMANG mobile application can be downloaded from the Google Play store or students can access it on the official website www.umang.gov.in. Students are required to register themselves on the UMANG app or website to access their CBSE 12th result 2024.

The step-wise process to download the CBSE results from the UMANG app is provided below:

- Install the UMANG mobile app or go to its official website www.umang.gov.in.
- Click on the 'Login/Register' option.
- If you have already registered, you need to log in with your mobile number. You can either choose to log in with your MPIN or OTP.
- If you are a new user, click on the option 'Register Here'. Follow the instructions and register using your mobile number.
- Now, scroll down to the 'Categories' section, and click on the option 'Education, Skills & Employment'.
- Now click on 'CBSE'.
- A new page will open up for services related to CBSE Board. Click on the 'Open' button under the 'Services'.

CBSE Class 12 Result 2024: How to Check Using DigiLocker?

DigiLocker is a part of the Digital India initiative launched by the Government of India to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy. It is an online platform to provide a digital wallet to its citizens to store and access their important documents and certificates in a secure manner.

- It is a cloud-based storage platform that enables Indian citizens to store and share their personal and educational documents with government agencies, educational institutions, and other service providers in a paperless manner.

- DigiLocker allows users to access their documents anytime, anywhere, and on any device. It offers features such as eSign, which allows users to sign documents electronically and also provides a facility to verify the authenticity of documents uploaded on the platform.
- Some of the important documents that can be stored in DigiLocker include an Aadhaar card, driving license, PAN card, mark sheets, and other academic certificates.

How to sign up for Digilocker to check CBSE Class 12 Result 2024?

To sign up for DigiLocker and check your class 12 result 2024, follow these steps:

- Go to the DigiLocker website at <https://cbseervices.digilocker.gov.in/activatecbse>.
- Click on the "Sign Up" button in the top right corner of the page.
- Enter your mobile number, and then click on "Get OTP".
- You will receive a one-time password (OTP) on your mobile phone. Enter this OTP in the box provided on the screen.
- Next, enter your name, email address, and password of your choice.
- Select your preferred language, and then click on the "Sign Up" button.
- Once you have signed up, log in to your DigiLocker account.
- Click on the "Issuer Documents" option on the left-hand side of the screen.
- Look for the document from the issuer that has issued your class 12 result. In this case, it may be your school, state board, or another authority.
- Click on the document to view and download it.

Steps to Access Results through SMS Organizer App

You can also check your CBSE Board result through the SMS organizer app by following the below steps:

Step 1: Open the Google play store and install the SMS organizer app.

Step 2: Open the app and allow for contacts, SMS, storage, etc.

Step 3: Now register for the notification of the CBSE class 12 result 2024 declaration.

Step 4: On receiving the result notification, open the link provided in the notification bar.

Step 5: Enter roll number, admit card ID, and school number and click on submit.

Step 6: CBSE class 12th result will open on the screen.

CBSE Result 2024 Class 12 by Name

CBSE does not provide any such facility to check CBSE Result 2024 Class 12 by name. Students can only check their results using their roll number whether it be through official website, SMS, DigiLocker or any other way. Name-wise results are not accessible to schools also.

RT Meaning in CBSE Marksheet

RT in CBSE marksheet stands for "Repeat Theory". This indicates that you have not scored the passing marks in the theory exam for that subject. Students getting 'RT' in a subject have to reappear only for the theory paper of that subject in [CBSE Class 12 Compartment Exam](#). The practical marks will be carried forward.

What is Essential Repeat in CBSE Class 12th Result?

CBSE first introduced the term 'Essential Repeat' in the year 2020 to replace the term 'Fail'. As per CBSE, the use of term 'Fail' is itself negative and demotivating to students. However, only the name has been changed not the rules.

An 'Essential Repeat' in CBSE Class 12 Result signifies that you have failed in 3 or more subjects in your board exams. This makes you ineligible to sit for the compartment exams conducted by CBSE.

- Students placed in 'Essential Repeat' category have to reappear for the class 12th board exams next year.
- If you have passed practical exams, and got essential repeat for theory papers, then you need to reappear for theory papers only.
- Your practical marks will be carried forward for preparing your final result.
- Students under 'Essential Repeat' category will be required to submit their applications next year to appear for the exams or they can choose to appear for open board exams.

Percentage Calculator CBSE (How to Calculate Percentage of CBSE Class 12?)

As per the official notice from CBSE, no aggregate marks, division, or distinction shall be awarded to students in their CBSE class 12 marksheet. The marksheet will contain subject-wise theory, practical/internal assessment, and total marks. Along with the marks, subject-wise grades will also be mentioned on the marksheet.

However, you can easily calculate your percentage using your marks. The final percentage is calculated considering the main 5 or best 5 subjects (in case of students having additional subjects). You need to simply add the marks obtained in each subject and divide it by the total marks for all subjects. To convert into percentage, multiply the answer by 100.

For example - A student scored the following marks in CBSE Class 12 Result 2024 in the main 5 subjects:

- Subject 1 - 89
- Subject 2 - 90
- Subject 3 - 95
- Subject 4 - 95
- Subject 5 - 92

The aggregate marks for this student will be - $89+90+95+95+92 = 461$

Since the total marks per subject in CBSE Class 12 are 100, the aggregate marks will be 500. You need to divide the marks obtained by the aggregate marks, in this case, this will give;

$$461/500 = 0.922$$

Now, to convert this decimal number into percentage, multiply the result obtained by 100.

$$0.922 \times 100 = 92.2\%$$

How to Calculate CBSE Class 12 CGPA

Students can calculate their class 12 CGPA by following the given steps:

Step 1: Add the grade points of all the subjects.

Step 2: Now divide it by the total number of subjects.

Step 3: For example, if your grade points are 7, 8, 9, 7, 10, then your total CGPA would be = $(7+8+9+7+10) / 5 = 8.2$

How to Convert CBSE Class 12 CGPA to Percentage

Students can calculate their CBSE class 12 percentage from CGPA using the formula given below. The Cumulative Grade Point Average, generally called CGPA, is the average of the grade points obtained by students in each subject. It can be easily converted to a percentage through the following steps:

- Add the grade points scored in each subject in CBSE class 12.
- Divide the sum of the grade points by the total number of subjects to get the CGPA.
- Now, multiply the CGPA by 9.5 to get your percentage.

The above steps are illustrated through an example below:

Suppose the grade points scored by a candidate in the main 5 subjects are as follows:

- Physics - 9
- Chemistry - 10
- Mathematics - 10
- English - 8
- Physical Education - 9

Then, the overall CGPA will be given by

$$\text{CGPA} = (9 + 10 + 10 + 8 + 9) / 5$$

$$= 46 / 5$$

$$= 9.2$$

Now, to convert this CGPA into percentage, simply multiply it by 9.5,

$$\text{Percentage} = \text{CGPA} \times 9.5$$

$$= 9.2 \times 9.5$$

$$= 87.4\%$$

How Many Students Qualify CBSE Class 12?

Looking at the previous years' trends, you can expect the overall pass percentage in CBSE Class 12 Result 2024 to be somewhere between 85-90%. Last year, the overall pass percentage was recorded at 87.33% which was 5.38% less than the year 2022. A total of 1,25,705 students were placed in the compartment exam category.

You can check the statistics of previous years' CBSE Class 12 Result to get an idea about the number of students who qualify the exam and the number of students placed under the compartment exam category every year.

CBSE Class 12 Result 2024: Revaluation

Students who are not satisfied with their class 12 marks can apply for rechecking of their answer sheets. The application window for revaluation will be activated by the 3rd week of May, 2024. Students have to apply online and pay a fee of Rs. 500 for each subject. The detailed process of revaluation is given below:

- **Verification of Marks:** Students will have to first apply for verification of their answer sheets for any error in totalling of marks or unchecked answers. Once the verification is done, the students will be informed about their updated result.
- **Photocopy of Answer Sheets:** If a student is still not satisfied with the verification, then they can request for obtaining photocopy of their answer sheets. Students can obtain photocopy of answer sheets only for the subjects for which they applied for revaluation. Students who did not apply for verification can not obtain their answer sheets copy.
- **Revaluation:** After obtaining copy of answer sheets, students can compare their answers with the correct answer and in case of any checking errors, they can apply for re-evaluation of those answers. Re-evaluation will be done only for opted questions and not the complete paper.

The fee details for each of the above step is as follows:

CBSE Class 12 Revaluation Results 2024

CBSE Board has released the results of the class 12 revaluation process. Students can now check the changes in their marks and download the updated mark sheet from the official website.

- Click on 'Submit'.
- CBSE 12th revaluation results 2024 will be displayed on the screen. Download the results for future reference.

CBSE Class 12 Compartment Exams 2024

Students who are unable to pass the exams will be able to reappear through compartment exams. Applications for CBSE Class 12 Compartment Exams will be accepted online by paying INR. 300 per subject. This will be the final chance for class 12th students to pass the exams.

- The syllabus for compartment exams will remain the same as that of [CBSE Class 12 Syllabus](#).

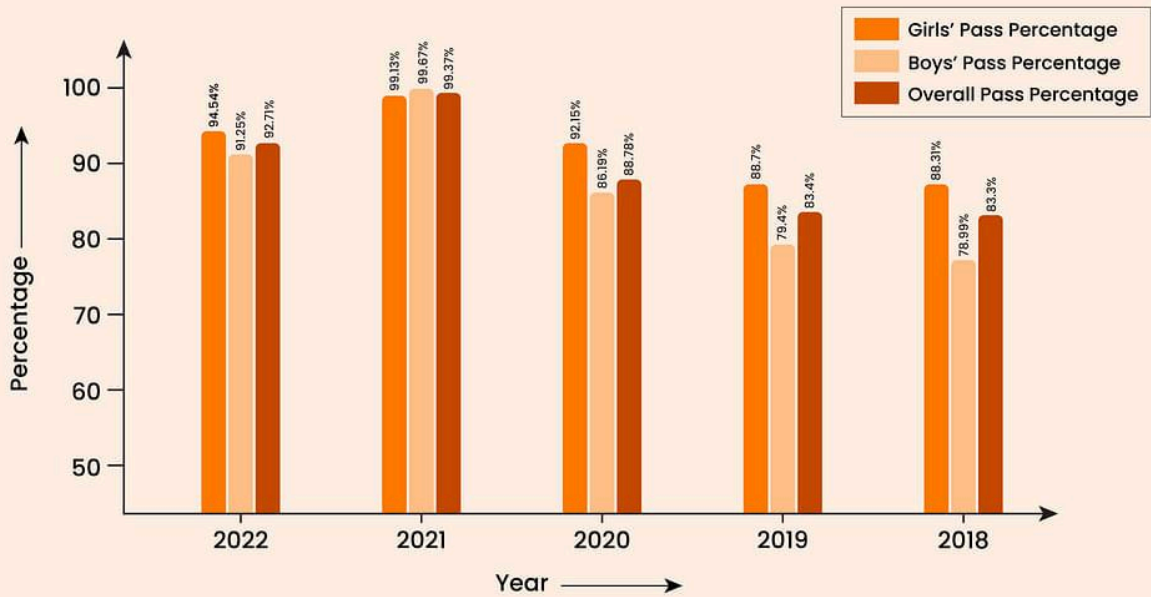
- Students will be able to check their compartment results online by entering the required credentials.

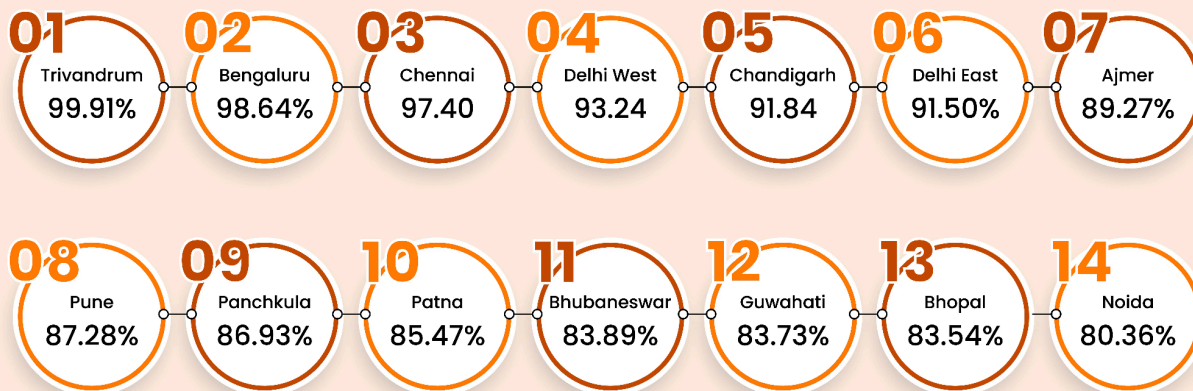
