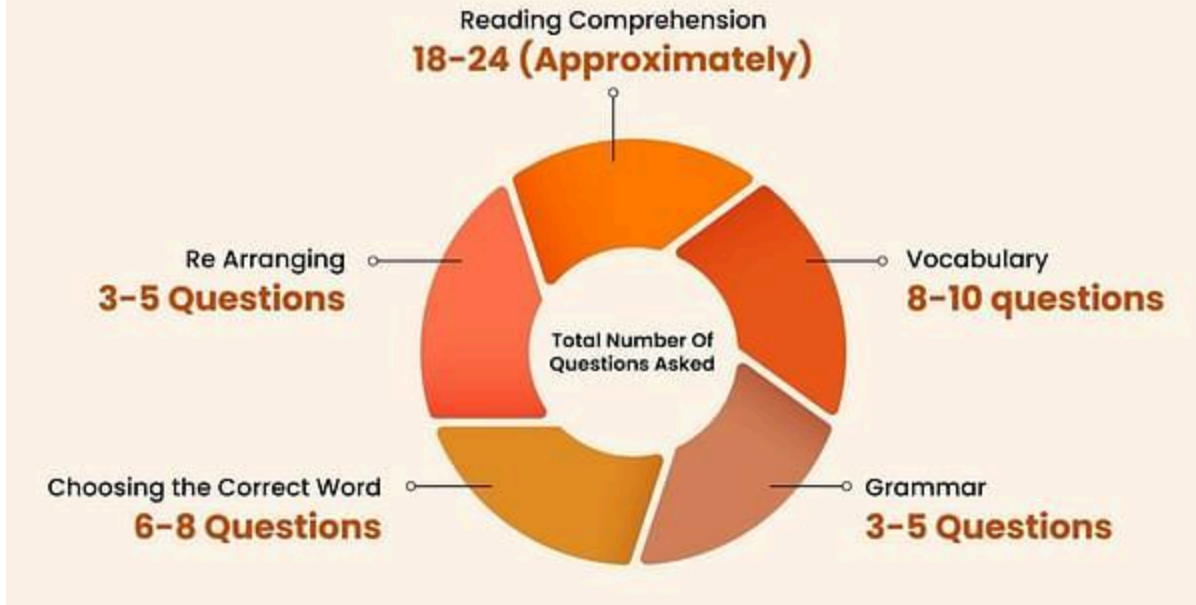
Is there any official release of the CUET English Syllabus 2025?

No, the exam authority did not release the CUET English Syllabus 2025. Each year the syllabus remains the same. If changed, the authority releases the revised syllabus at least one year before the exam.

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What Should Be Your Preparation Strategy for CUET 2025 English?

For CUET 2025 you have one year at your disposal, so break it to 6-4-2 format. For the first 6 months you will have to focus on priority based learning. Then for the next 4 months you should focus on your strong areas with proper guidance. The next 2 months are only for revision and practice.

Priority Based Learning: (6 Months)

At this stage, your focus area is Grammar, Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension.

Now, most of you have the same question: how many hours in a day should you invest in CUET English 2025 besides your regular study? For the language part or domain, 3 to 4 hours a day is enough for preparation.

What would You read within this Hour?

You will have to build a habit of newspaper reading. Reading newspapers for 1 to 2 hours a day will help you to improve your reading comprehension and vocabulary. If you are not interested in newspapers, then opt for novels. Besides that, you will have to practise basic grammar daily. For vocabulary, try to learn 5-10 vocabulary at a time. And the number will increase with your progress.

Focused Learning (4 Months)

Within 6 months, you will be able to identify your strong areas. At this stage, you need to strengthen those areas. You can start by making a comprehensive timetable. If you find that vocabulary is your strong area, invest less time. And indulge more time in practising your weak areas. Revise it, make short notes, and change your revision method if required.

Final Phase (2 Months)

- Revision and Recalling: Revise every single topic before the last 2 months of your exam. At this phase, the short notes you made in the previous stage will come in handy. Try to recall important topics from the brief notes.
- Practise PYQs: Practice PYQ or sample papers to measure your performance. Analyse every mistake that you made during solving. Make notes regarding your mistakes.
- Healthy Lifestyle: Try to maintain a healthy lifestyle by practising yoga, and eating nutritious foods. It will help you to stay positive and calm during exams.
