JEE Advanced 2024 Paper 1 Exam Analysis

JEE Advanced 2024 paper 1 was reported to be moderately difficult. Students found Math difficult, Chemistry moderate and Physics moderate to difficult in JEE Advanced 2024 paper 1. A detailed exam analysis for <u>JEE Advanced 2024 Paper 1 Question Paper</u> has been discussed below along with the exam pattern, marking scheme and negative marking.

JEE Advanced 2024 Paper 1 Question Paper Pattern

- JEE Advanced 2024 paper 1 total marks was 180 with 60 marks for each subject (same as last year).
- There were a total of 51 questions (17 questions in each subject).
- There were 4 sections in each subject,
 - Section 1- 12 marks
 - Section 2- 12 marks
 - Section 3- 24 marks
 - Section 4- 12 marks

JEE Advanced 2024 Paper 1 Marking Scheme

Each question in JEE Advanced 2024 paper 1 had a different marking scheme. JEE Advanced 2024 Paper 1 total marks for each subject was 60 marks.

- Marking Scheme for SAQs
 - o Full marks: +3 If only the correct option is chosen
 - Zero Marks: 0 for unattempted/ unanswered questions
 - Negative Marks: -1 In all other cases
- Marking Scheme for MAMCQs
 - Full marks: +4 only if all the correct options have been chosen.
 - Partial Marks:



- +3 If all four options are correct but ONLY three correct options are chosen
- +2 If three or more options are correct but only two correct options are chosen
- +1 If two or more options are correct but only one correct option is chosen
- Zero Marks: 0 for unattempted/ unanswered questions
- Negative Marks: -2 in all other cases
- Marking Scheme for Integer Type Questions
 - o Full marks: +4 for the correct answer
 - o Zero Marks: 0 for unattempted/ unanswered questions
- Marking Scheme for Matrix Match
 - Full marks: +3 in case all options are correct,
 - Zero Marks: 0 for unattempted/ unanswered questions
 - Negative Marks: -1 In all other cases
