EMBA PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Our EMBA is designed for a leader juggling a busy work schedule and life. Courses are a combination of two-day intensive sessions over a six-to-eight week period and week-long courses. During the Fall and Winter semesters, classes are scheduled on Fridays and Saturdays every two weeks. The EMBA program has an intake once every two years.

International applicants who intend to leave their employment to pursue their studies may be ineligible for this program. EMBA students are normally expected to be working full-time while completing the program.

MHRM PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Our MHRM consists of 10 courses and can be taken full or part-time. The MHRM program is offered through a combination of evening, online, live-stream, and one-week intensive delivery formats and **can be completed at a distance**. On average, our students complete the MHRM program in two and a half years*.

The Levene MHRM program is one of the first graduate programs in the country to be **accredited by The Chartered Professionals in Human Resources (CPHR) Saskatchewan**, making it easier for MHRM graduates to obtain their CPHR designation.

Applications received after the deadline are considered, but may not be processed in time for your preferred intake or in time to obtain your student visa. Apply early to ensure your application is processed in time for your desired intake!

STUDENT FEES

Additional student fees include:

Student Health and Dental Plan fees will be automatically charged \$218.50 for coverage full-time graduate students starting in the Fall semester. You can opt out of this charge by providing proof of other coverage. Students starting in Winter semesters can opt in for coverage.

Recreation and Athletic Fees are assessed at \$101.45 for each semester of registration.

The University of Regina Students' Union fees are assessed at \$41.55 per student plus \$5.30 per registered credit hour.

U-Pass Fee for all full-time and part-time students enrolled in at least one on-campus course are assessed at \$87.60. EMBA students can opt out of this charge.

Academic Technology Fee of \$23.05 per semester will be assessed to all students on campus and off campus.

The Co-operative Education Program is an opportunity for you to apply the principles learned in the classroom in a real-life work environment.

When you participate in the Co-op program, you gain paid work experience in an area related to your studies. Not only does this enhance your learning experience, but it also provides valuable networking opportunities for employment after graduation.

During Co-op placements, students are full-time employees, paid competitive salaries, and can be hired after graduation. This is your opportunity to earn while you learn!

Co-op is an optional program consisting of two work terms; either two separate four month terms or one eight month term with an optional third work term. You will receive ongoing support from the University of Regina Advising and Career Centre for resume preparation, job search, and work placement.

Make the most of your learning and gain real-life experience that will enhance your resume, upgrade your interview skills, and improve your job search abilities.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Co-op option, students must have completed a minimum of 12 credit hours, be a full-time student in good standing with no failing grades, and normally have obtained a minimum CGPA of 75% before applying.

CREDIT

Co-op is a non-credit program. After successful completion of each work term, including the evaluation and work term report, you will attain a passing grade for the work term.

FEES

Should you receive a placement, Co-op fees are assessed in the semester that you are registered for your work term. In addition, other full-time mandatory student fees and the international surcharge (if applicable) apply.

LEVENE MBA ADVANTAGE ENTRANCE AWARD

Domestic applicants with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the Paul J. Hill School of Business or a B. Admin degree from the First Nations University of Canada may be eligible for up to \$2,500 toward their pursuit of a Levene MBA and HBS Online CORE Certificate.

Candidates with an exceptional GMAT score and incoming CGPA may be eligible for a multi-year, automatic entrance scholarship.

INDIGENOUS PATHWAYS AWARD

The Indigenous Pathway Award is a \$20,000 CAD multi-year award available through the Levene Indigenous Pathways Program. The initiative recognizes that all Canadians benefit from quality education and the economic impact of robust and successful Indigenous businesses.

Eligibility

The Indigenous Pathway Award may be available to Indigenous students who have completed high school and are pursuing a post-secondary education or who have completed an undergraduate degree and want to pursue graduate-level education.
