Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer subject cited above and to say that the Ministry has received various representation requesting to reduce the required percentile criteria in the NEET-2020 in order to be eligible for admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H) UG courses, due to various reasons.

2. In this regard, the matter has been examined by the Ministry and decided that in order to be eligible for admission in ASU & H UG courses, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 40th percentile in NEET-2020.

However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35th percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30th percentile for SC/ST/OBC.

- 3. This clarification is applicable only for academic year 2020-21.
- 4. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
