

on the chief guest. Sometimes, they even make exaggerated and false claims about the chief guest. I feel this unnecessary praising is the highest form of corruption, where people are easily fooled, and it encourages those who are praised to develop an inflated opinion of themselves. That's why in the twelfth century, in Karnataka the great revolutionary leader Basaveshwara warned in his teaching that praise is like a golden gallows. After the function, I met the three poor bright boys whom the secretary had told me about. They were a little puzzled, shy and nervous. All of them had the same story. Father in a small job unable to make ends meet, large families back in the village, no land or any other assets. Only sheer determination to excel in studies had brought them here against all odds.
